AC 91-67	06/28/1991	Minimum Equipment Requirements for General Aviation Operations Under FAR Part 91	AFS-820	AC 91-67, last updated in 1991, is now misaligned with the latest ICAO standards. AFS-820 is in the process of making the required revisions to the document for alignment with the latest ICAO guidance. Until that can be completed, AFS-820 will cancel AC 91-67 so improper guidance is not used by operators. A release of a notice will bridge between the old cancelled guidance and the revision.
